## CALL FOR PAPERS

The Society for Philosophy and Psychology is calling for contributed papers and symposium proposals for its 16th Annual Meeting to be held June 8-11, 1990 at the University of Maryland, College Park, Maryland.

Contributed papers are refereed and selected on the basis of quality and relevance to both psychologists and philosophers. Psychologists, neuroscientists, linguists, computer scientists, and biologists are encouraged to report experimental, theoretical and clinical work that they judge to have philosophical significance.

Contributed papers are for oral presentation and should not exceed a length of 30 minutes (about 12 double-spaced pages). Papers must be accompanied by a camera-ready 300-word abstract. The deadline for submission is January 5, 1990. Send three copies to the Program Chair, Prof. Janet Andrews, Department of Psychology, Box 146, Vassar College, Poughkeepsie, NY 12601.

Symposium proposals should also be sent to the same address as soon as possible.
