Abstract: Early experiments on iconic memory suggested that people initially experience a detailed visual image but can report only a few cued items. We hypothesized that strong top down predictions would allow for visual experience of only task relevant information. In a change detection task we manipulated the appearance of visual stimuli in the critical part of the experiment by removing up to 70
